Dear Argyle Community,

I hope you have had an enjoyable winter break.

I regret to inform you that the Argyle gyms and equipment rooms have been significantly impacted by flooding that happened this week. Flooding was caused by runoff from the upper field area, which led to gravel washing over the retaining wall and blocking the exterior sidewalk drains, and water entering the gym through the west exit doors.

The school district's Facilities and Maintenance team, insurance adjustors, and a restoration company have been on site to dry the area and make initial assessments. Unfortunately, the damage to the floor is extensive and requires an immediate closure of both the small and large gyms. Once we have a more comprehensive understanding of the scope of the repairs and time needed for the repairs, I will update the Argyle community.

I was deeply saddened to receive this news yesterday as I know how important the gym facilities are to the Argyle community. I know the incredible strain this places on our PHE classes and athletics and am actively working on finding alternatives for both PHE classes and athletics; however, please understand this will take some time.

Thank you for your understanding, patience and support. I will provide further updates as they become available.
