Hello Argyle Families,

We are nearing the halfway point of the year with just 5 days left in semester 1. Please take note of the "Semester End" section below to learn more about review & completion, semester turnaround around, and the start of semester 2.

We received good news this week that the gym floor repairs will be contained to the centre gym (the south half of the large gym). The small gym reopened this week so we now have it and the north half of the large gym which reopened during the first week back. We are working with the contractor and, contingent on delivery of materials, we anticipate renewal work will be completed by the end of March. This includes applying finishing coats to the entire gym floor over Spring Break. We will continue to provide updates as the work continues.

This week, secondary school students, families and staff will have received an email with an invitation to participate in the Secondary Schedule Survey asking whether you would prefer a linear or semester system next year. Feedback received will be used to help the school district plan for the coming school year. The deadline to participate in the survey is Tuesday, January 31<sup>st</sup>. The survey takes less than a minute and we encourage all to participate.

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### 1. Semester 1 End & Semester 2 Start-up

We are nearing the end of semester 1. Students should be making use of daily flex time for studying, receiving extra help, and working on assignments and projects.

At the end of semester 1 students need to return any textbooks and novels to the library to be scanned in. Books not returned will be assessed a replacement fee.


The last day of classes for semester 1 is Friday, January 27<sup>th</sup>. This is a full day of school.

Monday, January 30<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, January 31<sup>st</sup> are *Review and Completion* days. Students with outstanding work to be completed need to attend on these days. Students needing to come in should schedule appointments with their teachers on these days. Students who do not have outstanding work to complete do not need to attend on these days.

Wednesday, February 1<sup>st</sup> is *Semester Turnaround Day*. There are no classes in session and the school is closed to students on this day.

Thursday, February 2<sup>nd</sup> is the first day of semester 2 classes and the block rotation will be 5678. 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# 2. Planning for 2023 - 2024 - Parent info sessions

Planning for the 2023-2024 school year has begun. There are **several parent information sessions** over the next month that we want to draw our attention to.

The Post-Secondary Information (PSI) night for students currently in grade 10 & 11 and their parents is on Wednesday, January 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in Argyle's multipurpose space. It is recommended that students plan out their grade 11 and 12 years at the same time.

Information about course offerings and graduation will be presented at 6:30pm on Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup> for parents/guardians of current grade 10 and 11 students and at 7:30pm for parents/guardians of current grade 8 & 9 students. A course planning information session for students will take place during period 6 on Thursday, February 9<sup>th</sup>.

Grade 7 students who attend an Argyle feeder school will receive information shortly. This information will also be posted on the Argyle website so it is available to all families including those not from one of our feeder schools. The grade 7 parent info night is on Monday, Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm.

All course programming sessions will be in-person with presentation slides posted on the Argyle website after each event.

# 3. Yearbook - Order by February 1st

The deadline to order a yearbook is February 1<sup>st</sup>. To order a yearbook, log in to School Cash Online and select the yearbook fee to pay. We do not order extra yearbooks so make sure to order yours by February 1<sup>st</sup>. The yearbook is completed throughout the year by students in the yearbook class and students receive it at the end of June.


#### B. Scholarship & bursary application deadline - By 9:00 am on Friday, January 27th

### 10. Health Reminders from VCH



When should I keep my sick child home from school?

Things to consider if your child feels unwell:

- 1. The wellbeing of your child. Without proper rest, a child may have a hard time fighting an illness or be at risk for other illnesses.
- 2. The ability of your child to actively take part and learn at school.
- 3. The school staff cannot care for a sick child and give them the support that they may need.
- 4. The protection of other children.

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Please keep your child home if they:

- 1. Have a fever.
- 2. Are too sick to take part in all normal school activities.
- 3. Have a suspected or known communicable disease (i.e. strep throat, chicken pox, measles).
- 4. Are vomiting or have diarrhea. It is recommended that students be symptom free <u>at least</u> 24 hours before returning to school.

Keep your child home until they are able to participate fully in normal school activities or as told by a health care provider.
