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1. January 2022 COVID Protocols

Health and safety remain a top priority this year. Please ensure you have read Superintendent Pearmain's January 7th update.

Most importantly:

- ✓ Students and staff must complete a <u>daily health check</u> and stay home if they have any symptoms of illness.
- ✓ Limiting visitors and volunteers to those who are essential to supporting activities that are of direct benefit to student learning and well-being.
- ✓ No spectators at events including athletic games.
- ✓ A well fitted mask is required in all indoor spaces except when eating/drinking, and when engaging in high-intensity physical activity. Masks must be worn over the nose and chin.



- ✓ If unable to wear a mask due to an exception, (as listed <u>HERE</u>, starting on page 20), please consider one of the alternatives shared <u>HERE</u> by the BCCDC.)
- ✓ Frequent handwashing
- ✓ Physical distancing is encouraged.
- ✓ Students should not share food or drink.
- ✓ Get vaccinated if eligible to do so.

Additionally:

- ✓ Students will be asked to use designated entrances & exits closest to their classroom.
- ✓ We have many sinks in the new school. Students need to hand wash upon arrival at school and frequently throughout the day. We have also put hand sanitizer in classrooms and at the front entrance.
- ✓ Breaks will be staggered by learning community.
- ✓ Lunch:
 - Students with a study block before or after lunch are asked not to be at school during lunch.
 - o Students are encouraged to eat outside or to go home for lunch where possible.
 - o Students staying at school need to spread out as much as possible.
 - o In addition to the usual areas students eat lunch we have opened 20 classrooms where students can eat. Classrooms have a max 50% capacity during lunch. Furniture has been reduced and reorganized in some common areas to reduce crowding. The cafeteria is standing tables only at this time.
 - Students need to keep their masks on except for when putting food/drink in their mouth.

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- ✓ End of day
 - Students are asked to leave school immediately upon completion of classes unless staying for an activity after school.
- ✓ Argyle's ventilation system includes MERV-13 filters, and 100% outside air intake. Air intake is at maximum levels and operations have been extended by 2 hours both pre and post occupancy.

If your student develops symptoms while at school

Your child needs to:

- 1. Tell their teacher they feel unwell
- 2. Come to the office and contact a parent/guardian
- 3. Isolate at home

If your student is at home ill

If your student is symptomatic or isolating but is well enough to do some schoolwork at home they should:

- o Check Teams for notes/assignments/class messages
- Contact their teacher on Teams

If your student forgets a mask

Your student should report to the front entrance where a supervision aide will provide a mask. They should not enter the school until they have a mask. If a supervision aide is not there they can come into the office to pick up a mask.

2. Pickup & Drop off

As part of our goal to minimize crowding we are asking students to exit the building through a variety of doorways with very few students actually exiting through the front doors. To assist us we respectfully ask parents to pick up their child in other locations in the neighborhood. Please note that our new upper parking lot and community entrance is now accessible and many students will be exiting the building from that area.

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3. Attendance

Please report student absences by email: argyle@sd44.ca. Please ensure the word "absence" appears in the subject line and please put your student's full name and grade in the body of the email. You can also notify the school of a students' late arrival or early dismissal. Students who are late should go directly to their class not the office.

Parents may also leave a message at 604-903-3314 to report a student absence, late arrival or early dismissal. Students cannot call in their own absence; only messages from parents and legal guardians are accepted. We prefer email whenever possible.

4. Tech Access: Chromebooks for Students

Through a generous donation from a community member we have several Chromebooks available to loan to students in financial need. Please contact an administrator to request one. These will be issued on a first come first served basis. There are also laptops available for day-time student use in the library.

5. Winter Weather

Please ensure your child has appropriate clothing and footwear for winter conditions and allow extra time to get to school. All NVSD schools will remain OPEN, if at all possible during winter weather, including snowfalls. Any district-wide closure will be decided by 6:30 a.m. and announced through the media, placed on the school district website and schools' websites, shared with parents/guardians via SchoolMessenger (email and/or text) and emailed to staff.
