

## 4. Mathematics Competition Team





# 9. Ministry Learning Survey - Parents/Guardians of Grade 10 & 12 Students

The Provincial Student Learning Survey is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools. It gathers information from parents/guardians/caregivers, staff, and students on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective.

The Student Learning Survey was administered to students in grades 10 and 12 this week. We encourage parents/guardians/caregivers of students in grades 10 and 12 to participate in this survey, as the results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement. The surveys contain standard questions for the Province and questions from the school.


### 10. Student Opportunities
