1. Mid Semester Report Cards

Mid semester report cards will be published to the MyEd Parent Portal on Monday, November 21st. Parents/guardians will receive an email from SysAdmin when the reports have been published.

3. School Start Time Reminder



4. Careers Department Update

Volunteer & Job board:

Argyle has a Careers Office and Work Experience Facilitators, Ms. Wilson and Ms. Burgerjon. Our facilitators support Argyle's Work Experience classes by finding internship placements for students. They also maintain a job and volunteer bulletin board outside the careers office (rm. 177).

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Careers 8 & 9 Updates:

- Grade 9 students participated in an assembly on October 27th during flex time to introduce them to the Careers 9 course and learn about the Take our kids to work day.
- Grade 9 students participated in the annual Grade 9 Take Our Kids to Work day on November 2nd.
- On Thursday November 17th all Grade 8 Students at Argyle are required to attend a morning assembly at 8:30am in the Large Gym during flextime. We are meeting to introduce Career Life Planning 8 and the Self-Assessment of the Core Competencies (SACC). During this time Mr. Duffy will be introducing himself, outlining the expectations of the course to ensure understanding, introducing MyBlueprint, and explaining the Self-assessment of the Core Competencies assignment.

Athletes of the week




