You are at the halfway point of your grad year! This week is an opportunity to finish any remaining semester 1 work, to set some goals for semester 2, and to take a moment to recharge your batteries before you embark on your final semester of high school.

For those who purchased a ticket we look forward to seeing you at the grad semi-formal tomorrow night. The event starts at 6:30pm and is at the Italian Cultural Centre (3075 Slocan St, Vancouver). Please make sure to bring student or government ID with you. All students will need to pass through a security check. At the entrance there is a room for coats and any large bags. Small bags/purses are allowed inside the ballroom. This is a school sponsored event and the school code of conduct is in effect. The event ends at 10pm.

This week there are two important deadlines to make note of:

1. YEARBOOK ORDER DEADLINE – Wednesday, February 1st

The last day to purchase a yearbook through School Cash Online is February 1st. We do not order extra yearbooks to sell in June. Every June we have grads who regret not ordering a yearbook; don't let this be you! Yearbooks are \$50 each.

2. GRAD YEARBOOK WRITE UP & BABY PHOTO – Due by Wednesday, February 1st

To acknowledge your experiences and growth we need a grad yearbook write-up and an optional baby photo to accompany your Grad photo in the Yearbook. NOTE: THE YEARBOOK WRITE-UP IS NOT SIMPLY A QUOTE FOR THE YEARBOOK. Although you may include a quote as part of your entry, the write-up is more a reflection of the key memories of your high school experience.
