A MESSAGE FROM MS. LAROUE and MS. WARDAS

As we approach Halloween, please be reminded of the following items and safety expectations:

- In past years, students arrived at school wearing their costumes, in anticipation of "the primary parade"
- we will have an outdoor parade around the field at approx. 9:10am if the weather permits. Adult
 assistance is not available for costumes, so please ensure your child has everything they need to
 be self-sufficient.

Please ensure your child has a change of clothes to change into after recess and they can change without adult assistance.

Please consider keeping costumes very low-key (wearing black and orange is totally fine), and culturally sensitive. We cannot guarantee that costumes won't get damaged before the big day (or wet, if it is raining).

Costume reminders: be appropriate for an elementary school setting, follow the Boundary Code of Conduct, no weapons, face masks, or elaborate make-up. Costumes must be easily stored in a bag after recess.

We continue to encourage healthy eating and therefore, we thank you for not sending Halloween treats to school. Please do not send treats to share with the class on Halloween day. Thank you.

FOOD ACCESS and healthy eating

All schools in North Vancouver are provided with funds to support access to food for students. Boundary receives \$150.00 per week to buy fruit and veggies for students needing a little extra. This food is portioned daily, available to all students, and is located in the front foyer. Students are asked to *eat what is in their lunch first*, before accessing additional supports. The food access program is not intended to be a meal replacement.

In addition, Boundary receives a free weekly delivery of fruits/veggies/milk (this has not always been consistent, but the intention is for weekly delivery) provided by the BC Fruit and Veggie Association. The





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goal of this initiative is to provide all students with access to fruits and veggies that they may not have tried yet.

Both initiatives offer a great opportunity for discussing food and food choices with your child.

We've noticed that students are coming to the foyer for a piece of fruit without eating their own lunch first and sometimes saying, "I don't like my lunch today". Thank you kindly for having a discussion with your child about items they would like for recess and lunch... or better yet, involve them in the "planning and making" process of their lunch. We will encourage students to take items home that they don't like or want We know that growing students often need more calories, including protein options to sustain them. Variety is key! When students have a shared responsibility for packing their lunch, they are more inclined to eat the food they bring.
