Young artists ages 8 - 12 will explore their surroundings with artist Aimée Henny Brown in the beautiful setting of Paradise Valley. This environment provides an ideal source to explore concepts of landscape and architecture. Students will receive in-depth instruction in collage, drawing, painting and printmaking. Working in small studio groups, teachers emphasize individual skill development and artistic style. This week long studio program is well balanced with outdoor recreation and studio time.

Aimée completed her Masters in Fine and Media Arts at NSCAD University in 2007. Aimée's artistic practice engages archives, research and printed matter to place historical content within her contemporary visual art practice. Aimée has exhibited her work nationally and internationally, with group shows in Germany, Los Angeles, and San Francisco. She has completed several artist residencies in North America. She is non-regular faculty at Emily Carr University of Art + Design, and hosts public workshops in and around Vancouver on a wide range of topics related to contemporary art.

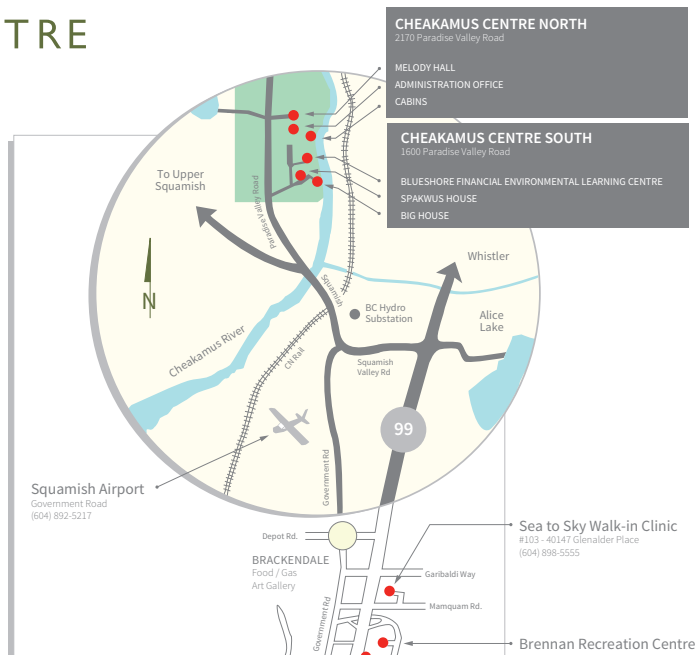
DRIVING TO CHEAKAMUS CENTRE

Heading NORTH on #99

Drive 10km past downtown Squamish to the Alice Lake turnoff.

TURN LEFT (west) off highway 99 across from the Alice Lake turnoff on to Squamish Valley Road.

KEEP RIGHT over CN Rail tracks past Cheeky, over bridge and take the right fork on the Paradise Valley Road.



Supervision is provided by the summer school coordinator, professional art teachers and outdoor school counsellors.

First Aid is provided by qualified first aid personnel who are on-site 24 hours a day to dispense medication and attend to any emergencies.

Meals include breakfast, lunch, dinner, plus 2 daily snacks. All meals are prepared in a professional kitchen on-site. (dietary restrictions accommodated)

Sleeping (yes, we do sleep!) there are several well-maintained cabins with bunks to accommodate up to 10 students with a counsellor.

Art Supplies and a wealth of quality art materials including a sketchbook and the coveted Artists for Kids aprons will be provided for all daily activities.

Transportation we depart on Sunday, July 9 at 2:45 PM. We provide transportation to the camp from the North Vancouver Educational Services Centre, 2121 Lonsdale Ave. Students remain at the summer school site until 2:00 PM Friday, July 14. Transportation home from Paradise Valley is the responsibility of the students' parents or guardians. Students who reside outside Greater Vancouver will have return transportation to North Vancouver provided if necessary.
