

When to Keep a Sick Child Home

Please keep your sick child at home when he/she has any of the following symptoms:

- Fever Chills and fatigue
- Cough, sore throat
- Body aches/ headaches
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Constant runny nose
- A suspected or known communicable disease

Consider the following:

- The illness can spread to other children, their families and school staff
- Recovery can be delayed without adequate rest
- The schools inability to care for a child when he/she is sick
