INFORMED CONSENT- KAYAKING GRADE 7'S

April 16, 2018

Cove Cliff Elementary is sponsoring **optional** kayaking lessons, which have been arranged by Deep Cove Canoe and Kayaking Centre. These lessons will take place from May 18th to June 20th. Teachers will walk with students to and from the kayaking centre. Lessons will be conducted in 90-minute blocks. Each student will receive four 90-minute lessons and one 180-minute lessons. Students taking part in the first block of the day must meet at the school by 8:15 am. Students taking part in the last block of the day will return to the school at 3:15 pm. All students must be accompanied by their teacher to and from the site. This experience will provide students training in kayaking enabling them to enjoy the many recreational opportunities that exist in this sport and in our neighbourhood.

Kayaking is considered to be a high-risk activity. Accidents causing injury or death may occur while participating in kayaking. Accidents can be the result of the nature of the activity and can occur without any fault on either part of the student, the school board, or its employees, or the kayaking centre. Kayaking activities involve the risk of serious injury or death due to human error, equipment failure, weather or other hazards. By allowing your son or daughter to participate in these sports you are accepting the potential risk that an accident can occur.

NATURE AND SCOPE OF RISKS (may include but not limited to)

- drowning
- risks caused by sea traffic hazards (kayaks, canoes, boats)
- illness due to movement (sea sickness)
- weather hazards
- accidents from walking to and from the kayak centre

Students will be briefed on the dangers involved in kayaking/canoeing and on appropriate precautions to be taken. Students are required to complete and sign the *Student Awareness of Risk and Responsibility* form in order to demonstrate full understanding of the expectations, risks, safety precautions and responsibilities associated with kayaking before being permitted to participate. All students must participate in lessons with the qualified instructors provided by the program. Students will be required to wear a life vest at all times while participating in kayaking on the water. Students must remain with their teacher/instructor for the duration of the lessons. Students must abide by the school Code of Conduct, the District Code of Student Conduct, and water safety training provided by the Deep Cove Canoe and Kayak Centre.

LEVEL OF SUPERVISION

Students will be under the direct supervision of Cove Cliff staff and/or kayaking instructors from the time they leave the school, during instruction, and until they return to the school. Students will be assisted through the equipment process by school staff, volunteers and kayaking staff. All students will be guided to their respective grade groups for the beginning of lessons. All students must remain with their instructor for the entire lesson. The instructors will carry a cell phone and there is a land phone available for emergencies, as well. Adult to student supervision ratios range from 1:6 to 1:8. A first aid kit will be kept by instructors and at the kayaking centre.

If at any point one of the supervisors deems student behavior or attitude to be unsafe they will lose their kayaking privilege immediately and return to school. Continuation in the program will be determined by the Principal.

The cost of this program is \$110.00 per student. Please submit forms and payment by **Friday April 27, 2018**. **Note: This school kayaking program is optional.** Alternative arrangements will be made for students who do not participate.

- I am responsible for my behavior and attitude.
- I will not put the safety of myself or others in jeopardy.
- I will follow the instruction of my supervisors at all times.
