Is your child in KINDERGARTEN? Are their immunizations up-to-date?



If your child needs kindergarten vaccines book now: Public Health 604-983-6700 or Your Family Doctor

- Vaccines are a healthy choice for your child.
- They provide immunity and prevent disease.
- Two vaccines are provided free for Kindergarten age children starting at age four:
 - Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Polio (DTPPO)
 - 2. Chickenpox (Varicella), dose two

During your kindergarten visit your child's record will be checked for protection against the following diseases:

- ✓ Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Polio
- √ Hepatitis B
- ✓ Meningococcal C
- ✓ MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- ✓ Pneumococcal
- √Varicella (Chickenpox)
