# How should I connect with my child's teacher?

Meet the Teacher. In early September, you will be invited to attend an evening information session with your child's teacher. This is a good time to ask your child's teacher about their preferred methods of communication and any other questions that you might have. Teachers are usually available after 3:00pm for brief meetings with parents. However, some may prefer to set up meeting times in advance. Teachers will also communicate via email or Microsoft Teams to send messages out to the families of their students. Learn more about the communications platforms you will be using below.
