

# YEAR-END 2023 STUDENT INFORMATION

# 1. LOCKERS

- On Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup> at 12:40 pm students will attend a short homeroom, followed by a school-wide locker clean-out. Lockers MUST be cleaned out by the end of the day Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup>
- Locks will be collected during Homeroom Wednesday, June 21<sup>st</sup>. Students will be given a tag with their combination to attach to their lock; all material must be removed from their locker by this time. Cleaning materials may be borrowed from the main office.
- If students were assigned a locker and do not hand in their lock, it will be considered an outstanding item and they will be assessed a fee invoice.
