Emergency Response Planning - Comfort Kits

Below is a message from Parents & Volunteers of the Westview PAC:

All North Vancouver Schools have comprehensive plans in place to provide care for your child in the event of an emergency/natural disaster (earthquake/fire/lockdown etc). Westview's PAC has equipped each classroom with an Emergency Response bag, First Aid Kit, foil blankets, rain ponchos, and emergency washroom supplies - with bottled water and emergency granola bars stored on site. We would like your assistance in the creation and implementation of a "Comfort Kit" program. The purpose of a Comfort Kit is to provide short term reassurance and basic supplies to your child in the event of an emergency situation. These kits will be stored in your classroom's Emergency Preparedness Bag, and would be distributed by the teacher if/when needed. Please place the following items in the ziplock bag that the PAC has provided for you, available for pick up from Mrs. Harman in the office. Label it with your child's full name, in permanent marker, and hand it back to your child's teacher *by Feb 28th*.

What goes into a Comfort Kit?

- 1 x small individual tissue pack
- 1 x family photo (please no names or personal information on the back)
- 1 x simple note of comfort from home (this can as basic as "Mommy/Daddy Loves you, we will be there soon")
- 2 x bandaids with their favourite cartoon character or colour
- 1 x a small nut free granola/snack bar
- 1 x a special item from home (this could be a small toy i.e. fidget spinner or small doll)

Please do not add any extra items. All kits should be the same and everything should fit inside the bag provided (see office). Please check the snack bar you include to make sure that it has an expiration date of at least July 2019 (to see through to end of school year). This comfort kit will be returned to you at the end of each school year for you to replenish and update as needed, and will be due back during the first week of school every September. Again, please return comfort kits to your child's

teacher, labelled and in the provided ziplock bag, by <u>no later than Feb 28th.</u> Thank you for your making this important addition to our Emergency Response Plan a top priority!
