The North Vancouver School District is offering a unique program for grade 7 students transitioning into Carson Graham Secondary School for grade 8. Summer Learning Grade 7/8 International Baccalaureate (IB - MYP) Transition is designed for students transitioning to an IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) school from grade 7. This course provides an opportunity for students to be introduced to the MYP curriculum: the IB Learner Profile, Key Concepts, Approaches to Learning skills, and criterion based assessment, in order to support greater success in grade 8 and beyond. The nature of the course will be experiential; students will work in a variety of environments on various learning engagements to develop skills and gain confidence for an MYP high school.
