March 8, 2024

Indigenous Students from Windsor attended the annual Youth Conference at the Chief Joe Mathias Centre. This year's theme was "Looking Within Ourselves."

The conference began with an inspiring speech by Brad Baker, Associate Superintendent of Indigenous Education at the Ministry of Education. 
PARKING AT WINDSOR
