The North Vancouver Board of Education is pleased to announce Trustee Antje Wilson has been elected Board Chair and Trustee Daniel Anderson Vice Chair for the next year. Trustee Wilson and Trustee Anderson will serve in their respective roles for the term commencing December 1, 2025.

The elections for Board Chair and Vice Chair took place at the November 18, 2025, Public Board Meeting, as required by [Policy 104: Board of Education – Meetings](#) and in accordance with [Policy 101: Board of Education – Role and Function](#) and Section 67(4) of the [School Act](#).

Also at the November 18, 2025, Public Board Meeting, Trustee Lailani Tumaneng and Trustee George Tsiakos were declared BC School Trustees Association (BCSTA) Board representative and alternate, respectively. Furthermore, Trustee Kulvir Mann and Trustee Cyndi Gerlach were declared BC Public School Employers' Association (BCPSEA) Board representative and alternate, respectively.

Trustees serving as BCSTA and BCPSEA Board representatives will serve in their respective roles for the term commencing January 1, 2026.

"I look forward to working with Trustees, staff, families and the greater North Vancouver community to fulfill British Columbia's vision for public schooling; supporting students' intellectual, human, social and career development."
