- Total Budget Bylaw \$225.1M
- \$2.0M required to balance Operating Budget
- No material changes to forecast anticipated
- Q3 financial report due to Ministry April 13.



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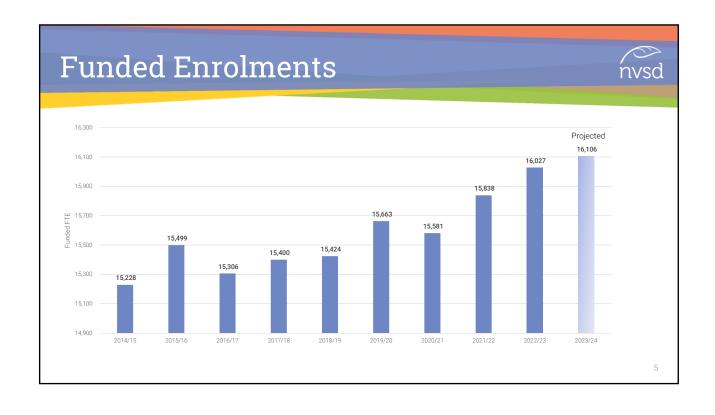

- Conservative enrolment for International Students

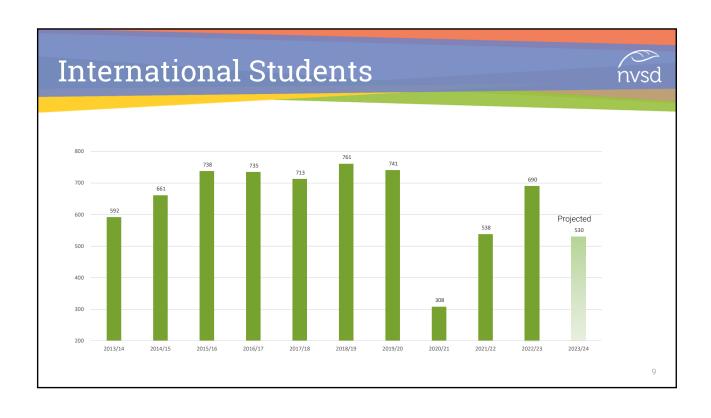

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2023/24 Planning Considerations



- Informed by best possible assumptions
- International enrolment historically higher later in the fiscal
- Salaries and benefits
 - Consistent with Collective Agreement requirements
 - Benefits costs per statutory obligations
 - COLA adjustments to be funded separately
- Inflation increases on services, supplies and utilities
- Surplus needed to balance the budget

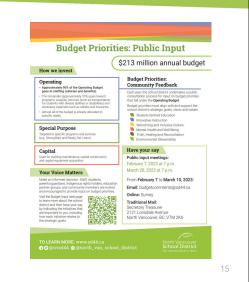
