North Vancouver Online Learning

- Provincial Online Learning School (POLS) Year 2
- "Classroom Alternative"
- 66 courses from Grade 8-12
- Aligned with the B.C. curriculum
- Designed & taught by certified teachers
- All instruction and resources delivered through Brightspace LMS

- 1892 (1450) students enrolled in secondary level courses
- Students from 146* (119) different schools across the province
- 34% (32%) of our student population from outside NVSD
- Every NVSD Family of Schools community enrolls in NVOL

Learning anywhere, anytime, on any device

- Continuous entry school
 - Enroll any time from September to June
- Asynchronous instructional model
 - Students begin courses when they are ready
- Students have one calendar year to complete from date of enrollment
 - Access to courses over the summer
