Elementary Band and Strings – Registration Open



The Elementary Band and Strings program is a unique instrumental music program that is distinctive to the North Vancouver School District.

Band and Strings complements the BC Ministry of Education's Arts Education curriculum and provides school-based instrumental ensemble instruction to students in the intermediate grades (Grades 5 - 7 for Band and Grades 4 - 7 for Strings).

Elementary Band and Strings is open to students in Grades 5-7 for Band and Grades 4-7 for Strings. Registration for the 2024/25 school year is open until Thursday, February 29.



Late French Immersion - Registration Open



The Late French Immersion Program is a two-year intensive program offered to all students who have successfully completed Grade 5. In Grade 6, 100% of instruction is delivered in French with an emphasis on oral French, to ensure effective language acquisition. English Language Arts are re-introduced in Grade 7 and represent 20% of instruction time, while all other subjects continue to be taught in French. In Grade 8, Late French Immersion students join their Early French Immersion peers for continuation of the French Immersion Program at the secondary level through to Grade 12.

Late French Immersion Feeder Schools are:

Boundary Elementary → Argyle Secondary

Braemar Elementary → Handsworth Secondary

Applications to the program will be accepted between January 9 and March 8, 2024.

Update From the Ministry of Education and Child Care



2023/24 Student Learning Survey

The <u>2023/24 Student Learning Survey</u> (SLS) for students in Grades 4, 7, 10 and 12, as well as parents, staff and principals/vice-principals is now open and should be completed by May 3, 2024. The student and staff surveys are available in English and French, and the parent survey is available in 18 languages.

An invitation for families to participate in the survey will be included in the monthly Superintendent's Reports and reminders in subsequent Events and Registrations starting with the Superintendent's Report of Thursday, January 25, 2024. In addition, on Thursday, April 25, a final reminder to participate will be sent to families of students in Grades 4, 7, 10 and 12.

Enrolment Audit 2023-24



The NVSD will be completing a K-12 Enrolment Audit for the 2023-24 school year. The two schools selected for this audit are **Mountainside Secondary** and **Handsworth Secondary**.

The enrolment audit will begin February 5, 2024, and the auditors will conclude their work in the NVSD on February 9, 2024. The enrolment audit will include reviews of 1701 data, careers programs, academies, and international education.

Government of Canada: Federal and Provincial International Student Caps



As of December 2023, the Honourable Marc Miller, Minster of Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship announced that the Government of Canada will set an intake cap on international student permit applications to stabilize new growth for a period of two years. More details are available in a news-release issued Monday, January 22, 2024. The NVSD will continue to monitor the potential impacts of these caps.
