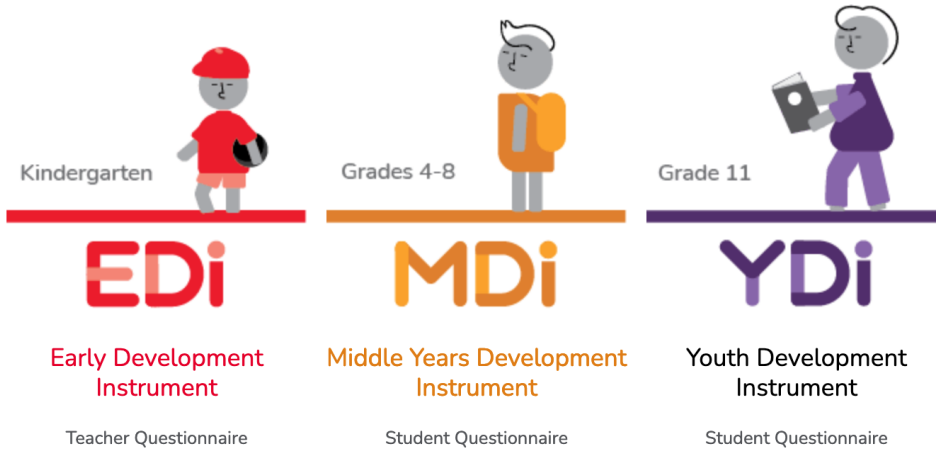
Track and Field Committee – 15 members (admin / teachers)

Zone Coordinators – 8 – 8 Zones - schools rotate each year taking the lead – organized by the committee

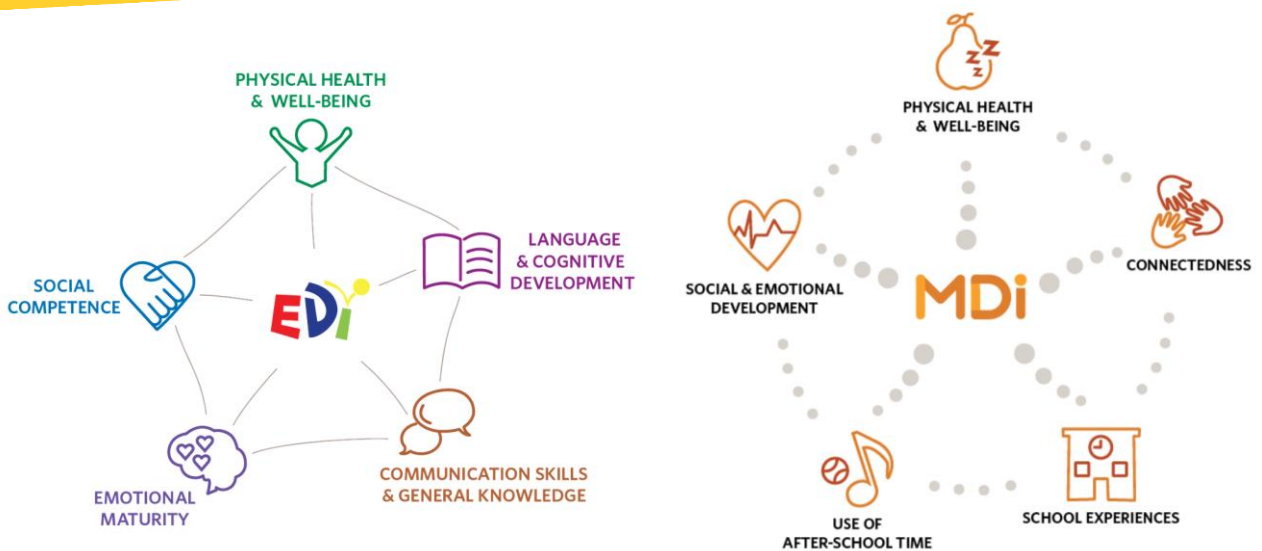
School Contacts – 24 – mixture of teachers / admin

Accessible BC Act – Accessible Organizations



Accessibility committee

- 9 (1) An organization must establish a committee to
- (a) assist the organization to identify barriers to individuals in or interacting with the organization, and
 - (b) advise the organization on how to remove and prevent barriers to individuals in or interacting with the organization.
- (2) An accessibility committee must, to the extent possible, have members who are selected in accordance with the following goals:
- (a) at least half of the members are
 - (i) persons with disabilities, or
 - (ii) individuals who support, or are from organizations that support, persons with disabilities;
 - (b) the members described in paragraph (a) reflect the diversity of persons with disabilities in British Columbia;
 - (c) at least one of the members is an Indigenous person;
 - (d) the committee reflects the diversity of persons in British Columbia.

Call For Committee Members



Recruiting for the SD44 Accessibility Committee:

- Seeking members with lived and learned accessibility experience and who represent the diversity of British Columbia, including those who are Indigenous

Composition Requirements:

- At least half of the committee members must, to the best extent possible, be people with disabilities or representatives of disability-serving organizations
- At least one member who identifies as Indigenous

Committee members will assist in:

- Identifying, preventing, and eliminating barriers to accessibility and inclusion for people with disabilities
- Contributing to the development of an Accessibility Plan and public feedback mechanism for our organization

LEA Process with Tsleil-Waututh Nation and Squamish Nation Education Protocol



Local Education Agreements are important aspects of the local First Nations and the NVSD's shared work. The NVSD continue to meet with leaders at the Tsleil-Waututh Nation.

NVSD executive is meeting with members of the Squamish Council's Community Service Committee, and Educational Director on May 15 to discuss student success and shared direction. In addition, we will be starting a new Education Protocol Process in the new school year.

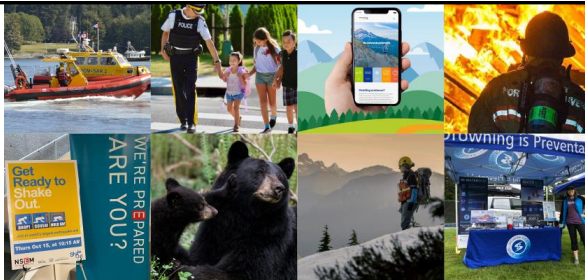
