

Goals and Measures

•Increase the number of Early Learning Foundation centres providing before and after school care by 3 in the next three years (baseline 2011: 10 ELF Centres, 13 locations with before and afterschool care).

12 ELF Centres, 7 Strong Start Centres, 20 locations with Family Friendly services

•Secure five additional partnerships with external organizations. (baseline 2011: current SJUAs and formal partnership agreements)
