





- 2. Student requests a transfer to another NVSD secondary school
- 3. Student is new to NVSD





Student Attends Feeder Secondary School



- No transfer/registration form required
- Student completes course selection, participates in Grade 7 to 8 transition activities

Student Requests a Transfer to Another NVSD School

- Grade 7 students who would like to attend a secondary school other than their designated feeder school
 - ✓ Complete a transfer form
 - ✓ Transfer requests must be submitted at Central Registration between January 25 and March 4, 2016
 - ✓ Not all transfer requests can be met



Student is New to NVSD

• Students **not** currently attending a North Vancouver School District school



- New students to North Vancouver must register at Central Registration beginning January 25, 2016
- Registration deadline for priority placement is March 4, 2016
