Parent Portal - Accessing and Viewing Student Portfolios


Portfolios are a student's own digital space to edit and curate allowing creation of collections of documents, presentations, blog posts, or other media (e.g., photographs, videos, certificates, rubrics, or assignments). A portfolio is much more than a digital scrapbook. It allows students to create a purposeful collection of their work that demonstrates their efforts, progress, and achievements that can be shared with teachers, administrators and parents. Teachers may post on behalf of their students', evidence of a student's progress and share reflections with student and parent.


Documents may be added from Office 365, Google or the Assignments feature of the classroom teacher's Class Site. Content may be easily added right in the browser from any device by logging in to www.sd44.ca. When the student moves or graduates, the Portfolio is portable.

Parents have a dedicated portal to view their own children's Portfolios. The classroom teacher will invite the parent to the Parent Portal and once the subscription is in effect, no other password or saved website is required. Each time the student or teacher adds to the Portfolio, an email notification is sent to the parent. The parent will only need to click on the link in the email to be directed to the Portfolio.

Joining the Parent Portal

Once a teacher invites you to join the parent portal, you will receive an invitation email from a district email address (e.g., sharepoint@sd44.ca)





Once registered, to return to the parent portal, go to https://my44.sd44.ca/parents & use your email address to sign in.
