The Digital Media Academy Lite (DMAL) goes beyond the technical skills and knowledge fundamentals for working with digital media. At its core, DMAL is a program that inspires and empowers young people to develop the habits of mind to be inquisitive, creative, imaginative, innovative, and highly motivated in the creation of meaningful results. Students have the opportunity to learn and work collaboratively on real-world projects.

Located at Argyle Secondary School, DMAL offers an enriched, project-based learning environment where students explore digital design, technology, project management and problem-solving. The program integrates Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics (STEAM), encouraging students to create meaningful stories and solve challenging design problems.

One of the main goals of DMAL is to prepare students for post-secondary training as well as the many career opportunities in Digital Media, Science, Engineering and Technology.

DMAL is ideal for highly motivated, self-directed learners with a strong interest in Science, Engineering, Design and Digital Media. Students work in cohorts and take their courses together which creates a dynamic and collaborative learning environment.

Learning extends beyond the classroom through masterclasses, industry presentations, workshops, and field trips, providing valuable exposure to professional practices and networks.

Fees

The total cost for the Digital Media Academy Lite is **\$525** for the 2026-2027 school year.

Payment: To confirm a student's registration and secure placement in the Academy for the 2026-27 school year, payment may be made in full or monthly instalments may be set up by the deadline stated in the acceptance letter.

Please note: Failure to pay the Academy Fee in full or set up monthly instalments by the deadline stated in the acceptance letter will result in automatic withdrawal from the Academy.

A limited number of bursaries are available for this Academy.

2. Submit supporting documents to academies@sd44.ca

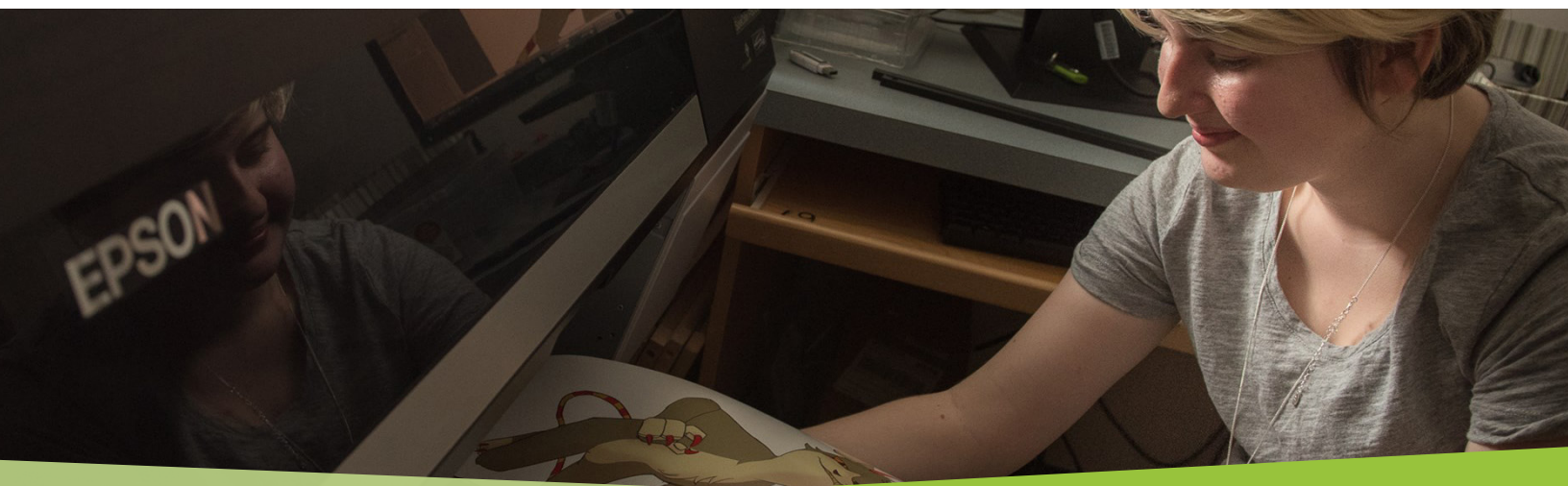
