

Rowing Academy

Since 2022, the North Vancouver School District has partnered with Deep Cove Rowing Club (a member of Rowing B.C. and Rowing Canada) to offer a program that replaces students' regular Physical and Health Education (P.H.E.) courses. Deep Cove Rowing Club (DCRC) has run youth rowing programs for nearly two decades. The DCRC boathouse is located in a District of North Vancouver building shared with Deep Cove Canoe and Kayak.

The program consists of a curriculum which complies with the P.H.E. curriculum established by the B.C. Ministry of Education and Child Care. Upon successful completion of the program, students earn their grade-level P.H.E. credit.

Who can Participate?

The Rowing Academy is open to all students in Grades 8-12.

Fees

The total cost for the Rowing Academy is **\$2,089** for the 2026-2027 school year.

Payment: To confirm a student's registration and secure placement in the Academy for the 2026-27 school year, payment may be made in full or monthly instalments may be set up by the deadline stated in the acceptance letter.

Please note: Failure to pay the Academy Fee in full or set up monthly instalments by the deadline stated in the acceptance letter will result in automatic withdrawal from the Academy.

A limited number of bursaries are available for this Academy.

Location and Schedule

The Rowing Academy is located at Seycove Secondary School and Deep Cove Rowing Club.

The final schedule for the 2026-2027 school year will be confirmed once the 2026-2027 school calendar has been finalized. It is provisionally expected to run in a 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. time slot, five times per two-week cycle.

Transportation to and from the Academy site is the sole responsibility of the student and/or parent/guardian.
