Fees

The total cost* for the RMD Academy is \$2,297.55 for the 2025-26 school year.

Deposit: To confirm a student's registration and secure placement in the Academy for the 2025-26 school year, a deposit of 10% is required by the deadline stated in acceptance letters.

Please Note: Non-payment by the deadline will result in automatic withdrawal from the Academy.

Remaining Fee: Parents/guardians may pay the remaining balance in full or set up instalments any time between the offer of acceptance and August 2025 through School Cash Online

Please Note: Failure to pay the balance in full or set up instalments by the deadline will result in automatic withdrawal from the Academy.

A limited number of bursaries are available for this Academy.

Selection for RMD

- Priority 1: Returning students
- Priority 2: Wait-listed students from the previous year
- Priority 3: Lottery for remaining students per Board Policy 605: Admission of Students to Schools

The total number of spots available will be dependent upon the number of returning students, the number of applications received, and the ability of schools to organize the school timetable to meet enrolment and programming requirements.
