Rowing Academy

North Vancouver School District is partnering with Deep Cove Rowing Club (a member of Rowing BC and Rowing Canada) to offer students a program that replaces students' regular Physical and Health Education (P.H.E.) courses. Deep Cove Rowing Club (DCRC) has run Youth rowing programs for nearly two decades. The DCRC boathouse is located in a District of North Vancouver building shared with Deep Cove Canoe and Kayak.

The program consists of a curriculum which complies with the P.H.E. curriculum established by the B.C. Ministry of Education and Child Care. Upon successful completion of the program, students earn their grade-level P.H.E. credit.
