

Volleyball Academy

at Sutherland Secondary School



The North Vancouver School District formed a partnership with Volleyball Canada in 2012 to offer the North Vancouver School District Volleyball Academy at Sutherland Secondary.

The Volleyball Academy consists of three co-ed, multi-graded streams:

- Stream 1 AM Focus on skill development for students who are new or newer to volleyball
- Stream 2 AM Focus on advancement of skill development and tactical awareness
- Stream 3 PM Focus on progressing towards skill and tactical refinement

Students new to the academy will be assessed and placed by Volleyball Canada coaches. Assessments will take place April 6 and 8, 2020 at Sutherland Secondary School. Students new to the academy must attend both assessment dates.

The program consists of the volleyball curriculum as set out by Volleyball Canada and the Physical and Health Education curriculum established by the B.C Ministry of Education. Students earn their grade level P.H.E. credit upon successful completion of the program.

The Academy is open to students in grades 8 – 12, and will be held either before school or Block 8 of the secondary school timetable, depending on the cohort.

Participation in the Volleyball Academy will not affect a student's eligibility to play for their home school's volleyball team.

* Transportation to and from the Academy site is the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Application Procedures

North Vancouver School District applicants apply online at <https://sd44.schoolcashonline.com/>. Out of District applicants may contact academies@sd44.ca to receive their application link.

Returning students must complete the online application.

Applications will be accepted from **January 20, 2020 to February 24, 2020.**

Selection for the Volleyball Academy

- Priority 1: Returning students
- Priority 2: Waitlisted students from the previous year
- Priority 3: Lottery for remaining students consistent with Board Policy 605: Admission of Students to Schools

The total number of spots available will be dependent upon the number of returning students, the number of applications received, and the ability of schools to organize the school timetable to meet enrollment and programming requirements.

Admission to competitive streams is determined through successful assessments and/or tryouts.

Fees for the Volleyball Academy

The total cost for the Volleyball Academy for the 2020-2021 school year is as follows:

- Stream 1 AM - \$1,885
- Stream 2 AM - \$2,175
- Stream 3 PM - \$2,175

Deposit: The non-refundable deposit is required on or before May 6, 2020 to confirm your child's registration and secure placement in the Academy for the 2020-2021 school year. Please note that non-payment by the deadline will result in withdrawal from the Academy.

Remaining Fee: Parents/Guardians may pay the balance in full or set-up installments any time between May and August 2020 through School Cash Online. Please note that failure to pay the balance in full or set-up installments by the deadline will result in withdrawal from the Academy.

An additional Programming Fee of approximately \$935 may apply to Out of District students.
