AFK Fall Teaching Exhibit Announcement!



Beyond the Horizon

Beyond the Horizon is an expression defined as "farther than the possible limit of sight, beyond what we can foresee, know or anticipate." It is both visual – what we see – and conceptual – what we know. The horizon as a metaphor provides us with an opportunity to challenge and evaluate our own ways of knowing. We can learn from artists' processes and works that represent ways to stretch our thinking, to experiment with new materials, to think expansively, and to create new conventions.

This exhibit explores artists' use of materials and collaboration as a means to redefine their artmaking practices and ways of thinking. This physical and cognitive process is represented in a variety of visual forms including sculpture, photography, textiles, drawing, painting, and printmaking.

For George Littlechild, the use of materials, vibrant colour, and personal imagery is therapeutic, purifying, and offers a means to reconnect with his culture. His work offers viewers opportunities to expand the horizon of thinking about history, culture, and identity.

Beyond the Horizon asks us, have you ever imagined how far the horizon stretches? What is beyond it? Will you explore it? What will you create as you expand your thinking?

Visiting OUR Gallery this Fall

In the 2021-2022 school year AFK is excited to launch a blended model for our Grade 5 Gallery Program!

AFK will offer a half-day Gallery Program to ALL grade 5 classes (including split classes) in the school district. In each program, led by AFK art educators, students will create art inspired by our fall teaching exhibition. Students will engage with the fall exhibition, either in-person at AFK or in classrooms via a virtual tour. The 2021-2022 Gallery Program will run



from the week of Sept. 27 until the week of Feb. 21.

By September 13, AFK will contact grade 5 teachers at schools that are in walking distance to the Gordon Smith Gallery. These teachers will have the opportunity to sign up for an in-person half-day Gallery Program at the Gordon Smith Gallery. Classes who are unable to walk to the Gallery will be contacted by October 15 and will have the opportunity to sign up for a half-day AFK Gallery Program in their classroom. An AFK Educator will travel to their school and lead an art activity in their class. This in-person school-based workshop will be followed by a virtual Gallery Tour, providing students with an opportunity to view and engage with artworks on exhibit.
