The Late French Immersion program begins in Grade 6 and continues through to Grade 12. It is a program for students who want to achieve functional bilingualism by the end of Grade 12. Most of the instruction at the Grade 6 and 7 levels is in French.

3. Submit a completed application between January 2nd and March 13th, 2026 at Central Registration\*.
