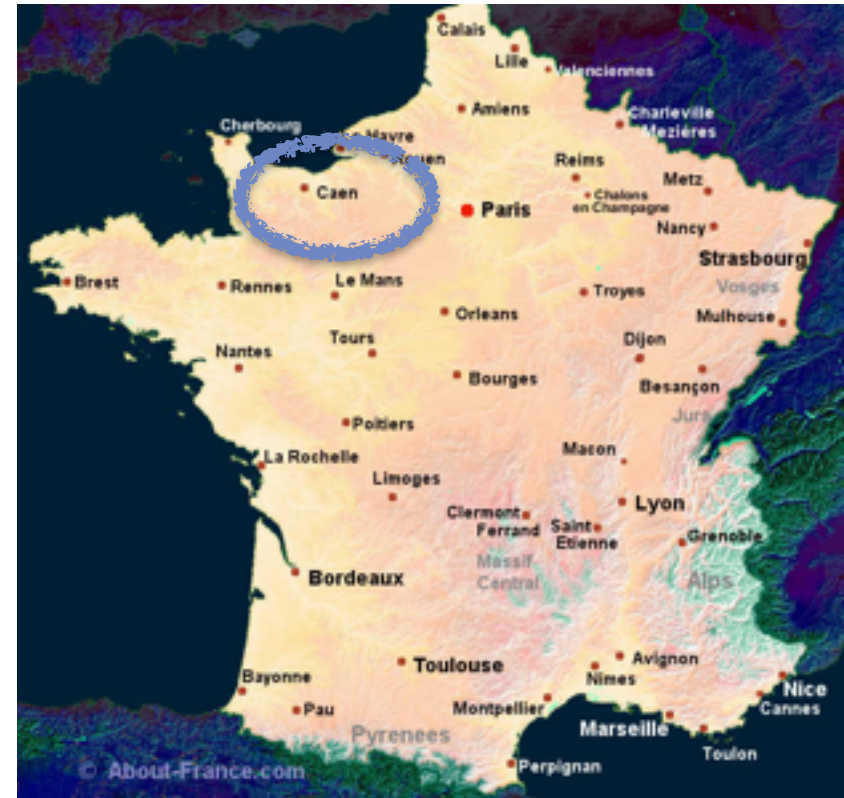

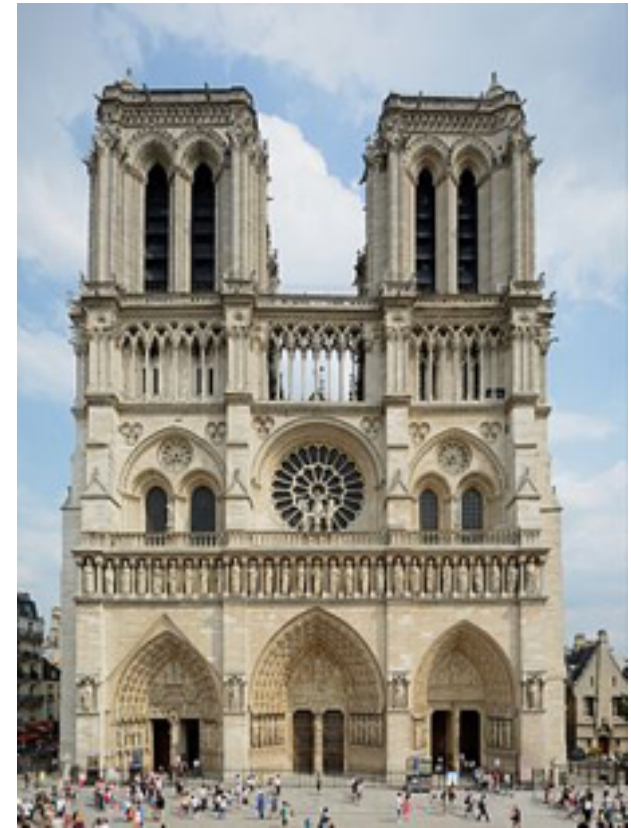
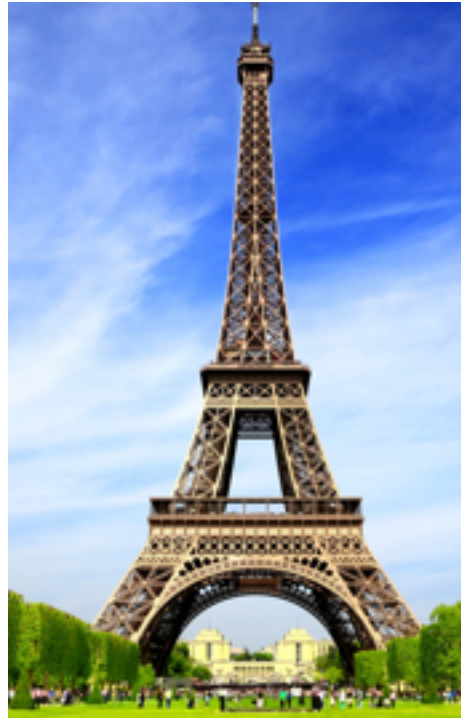

Safety and Security



- School District employees will supervise the students
- Students will spend most of the week in large groups; however students will also be permitted to travel in small groups or partners for brief periods of time with no adult supervision
- Students are expected to cooperative with and listen respectfully to group chaperones

Trip cost



- Approx. \$3,500 - \$3,900 per student (will depend on group size)
- Price includes round-trip airfare, 9 nights accommodations, chaperones, private tour director, entrance to all activities and all breakfasts and most dinners.
- Trip bookings will be managed by Explorica. Various payment plans are available.



Registration



- Registration will be first come, first served starting June 27th, 2018.
- Informed consent and medical forms handed in to Educational Services Centre must be submitted before September 20th at 4:00pm.
- Once confirmed, you will receive a link and code to register through the Explorica website. Non-refundable deposit (\$50) will be required at this time.



Travel Options



- Explorica **can** book individual flights for students (return only).
- Students will need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian in **Paris** before the scheduled departure date/time (March 23, 2019).
- Explorica will facilitate the appropriate bookings for students during the registration process.
