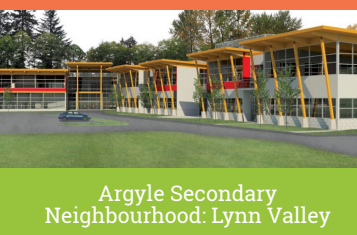


International Education Program

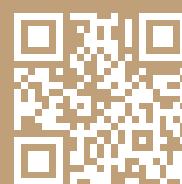

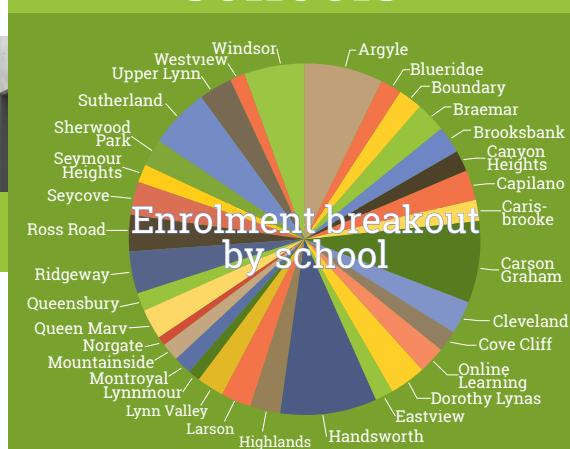

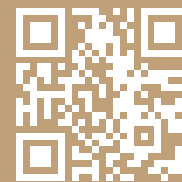
