Parent & Community Update September 2, 2021

Dear Cleveland Families:

Welcome to what will be a wonderful 2021-2022 school year! It is our pleasure to welcome everyone back and extend an especially warm welcome to families and students who are totally new to this wonderful Cleveland community.

We are very excited about the year ahead. We are hoping to gradually introduce more are more 'normal' aspects of school such as sports, more involved field trips, hot lunches, socials, and all those other things that help build a strong school community.

Next week on September 7th students (except Kindergarten students) return to school from 9:00am to 11:00am. They will go to last year's class assembly point and will be dismissed from there as well. Later in the afternoon of the 7th, teachers will send a welcome email out to their students and families with more detail about their class placement and where and how to meet on Wednesday September 8th. Be sure to check the <u>Cleveland School Website</u> on a regular basis for information, especially our 'Quick Links' section.

If you as an adult need to enter the school please make an appointment with a staff member who can connect with you or enter through the front door and check in with the main office. In either case you always need to use the 'daily health check' QR code to record your visit.

As mentioned in Superintendent Mark Pearmain's letter of August 24th, the Province provided updated Provincial COVID-19 Communicable Disease Guidelines for K-12 and has confirmed a return to full-time, in- person teaching and learning and the resumption of sports, music and other much anticipated extracurricular activities.

Highlights include:

- 1. Vaccinations. According to public health, vaccines are the most effective way to reduce the risk of COVID-19 in schools and communities. Public health and the North Vancouver School District continue to strongly encourage all British Columbians aged 12 and over, and particularly residents of the North Shore, to be fully vaccinated (receive 2 doses) to protect themselves and those around them.
- 2. **Staying Home When Ill and the Daily Health Check**. To reduce the likelihood of coming to a school when ill, students, staff and visitors are required to complete a daily health check prior to entering the building. Families and students can use the K-12 Health Check app. Visitors entering the building will be required to do a health check upon arrival using a provided QR code.

- 3. **Masks**. All students in grades 4 to 7, all staff, and visitors will be required to wear nonmedical masks in all indoor areas of schools, including when they are at work stations/desks.
- 4. **Cohorts**. Also known as learning groups, are no longer recommended by public health as a COVID-19 mitigation measure and will not be used for this school year.
- 5. **Physical Distancing**. While public health no longer recommends strict physical distancing of two metres, we will work on strategies to help with respecting personal space, including signage, encouragement to spread out, using available learning spaces and taking students and learning opportunities outside, where and when possible.
- 6. **COVID-19 School Exposure Notifications.** If a student or staff member is confirmed to have COVID-19 and potentially infectious while at school, public health (Vancouver Coastal Health) will continue to investigate and work closely with the school district and schools on next steps including timely action and communication.
