1. **Final Reminder - Grade 8 to 11 Course Request Verification Process for Next School Year**

Students entered their course selections prior to Spring Break and counsellors are now in the process of finalizing selections. **It is important at this time for parents to verify their child(ren)'s selections so that we have accurate data to build our timetable. Deadline to request changes to course requests via the counsellor is Wednesday, April 29th.**

Parents and students can verify their course selections via MyEd Parent Portal as below.

- a. Log in to the MyEd Parent Portal www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspn
- b. Click on the "Family" tab (upper left of window); you see a list of your children in MyEd
- c. Click on "Schedule" side tab
- d. Click on the "Requests" sub-side tab. You will see a list of a child's course requests. Review with your child and make note of any changes you wish to communicate to the school
 - If you have more than one child, click the < or > arrow in the upper right of the window; you will be able to move between children

If you have any course changes, please communicate these directly to your child's current counsellor via 'email'. Be sure to include:

- **Child's name and grade**
- **Course to be added / course to be dropped**
- **Your name**
