
## **Argyle Learning Centres**

**Standards** of the Core Subjects. Through this process students will develop their proficiencies in the **Core Competencies**.

The Learning Centres support students to develop skills in:

- Self advocacy
- Independence
- Executive functioning
- Self regulation
- Developing a personal learning profile for success
- Academic skills

In the Learning Centres (LC) students will:

- engage with LC staff to identify, develop and work on their individual learning needs
- be responsible and respectful for their own learning environment and the learning environment of others.
- self-evaluate their work habits each day.
