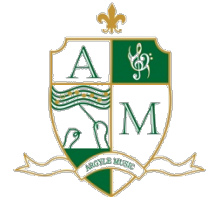

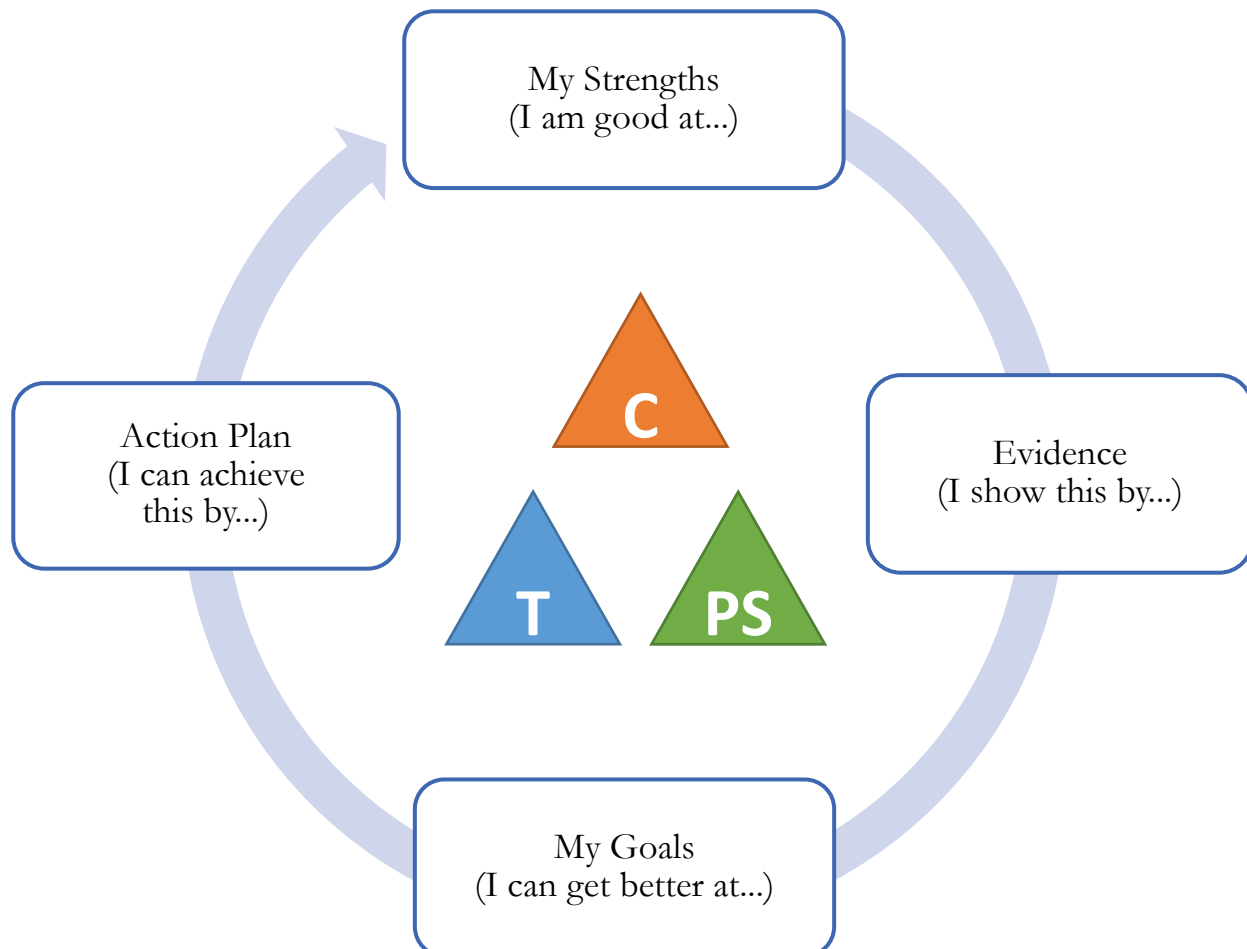
Overview / Goals

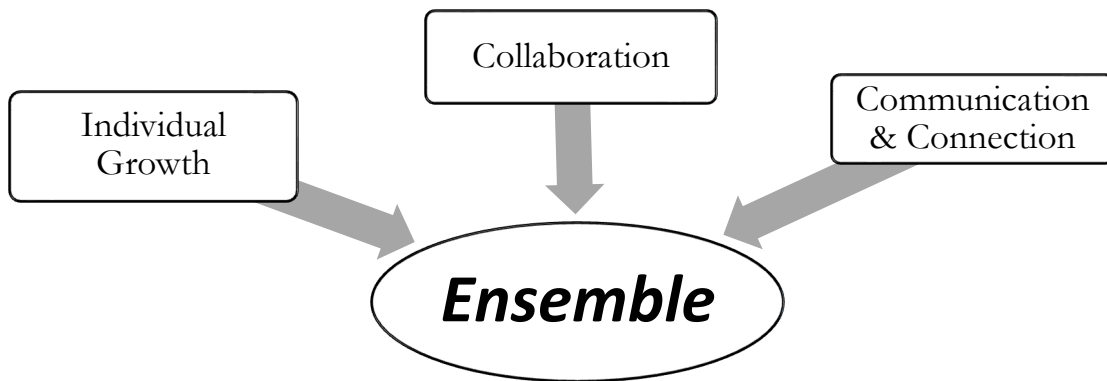


Class Specific Activities
