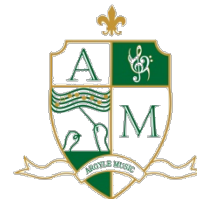

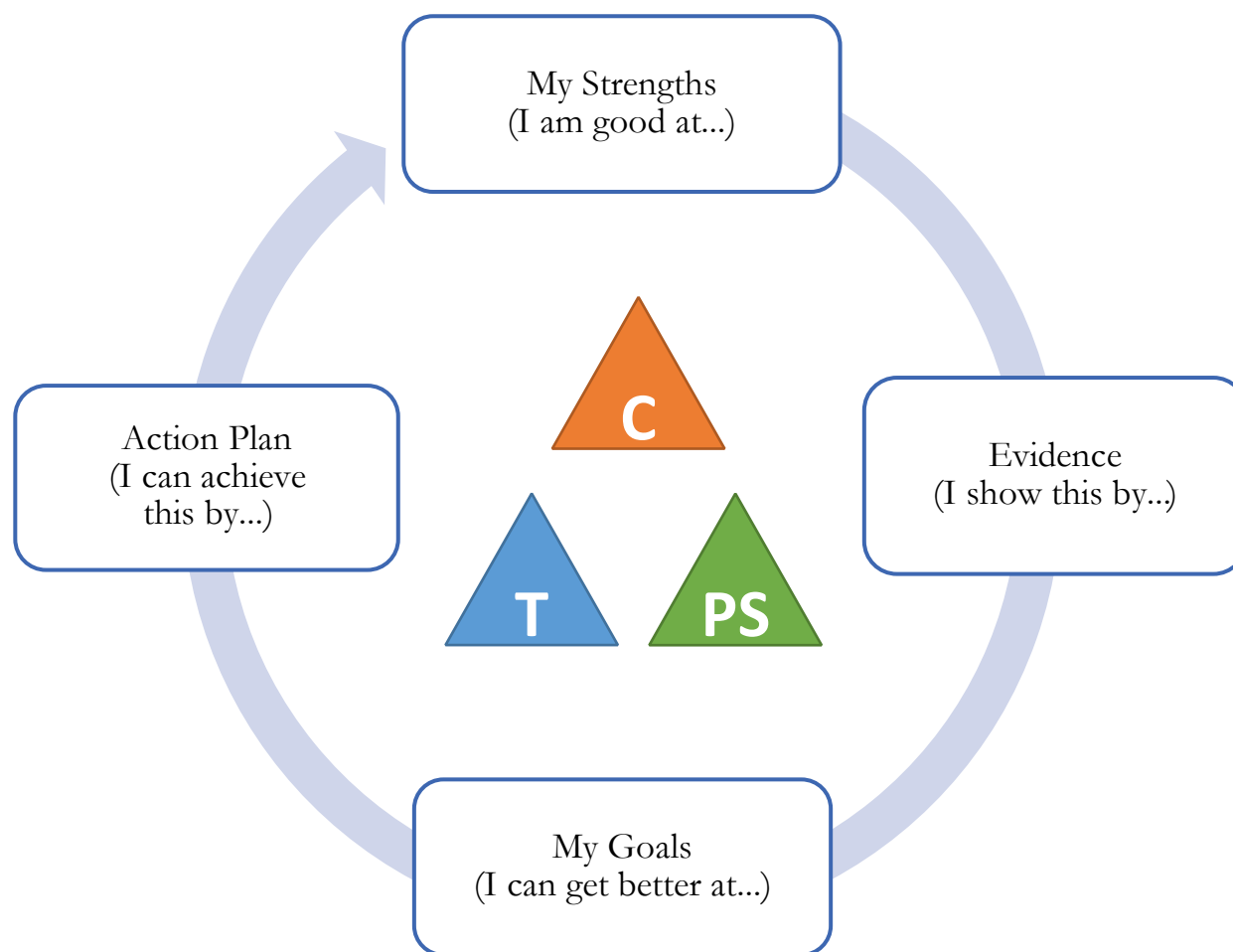
Overview / Goals

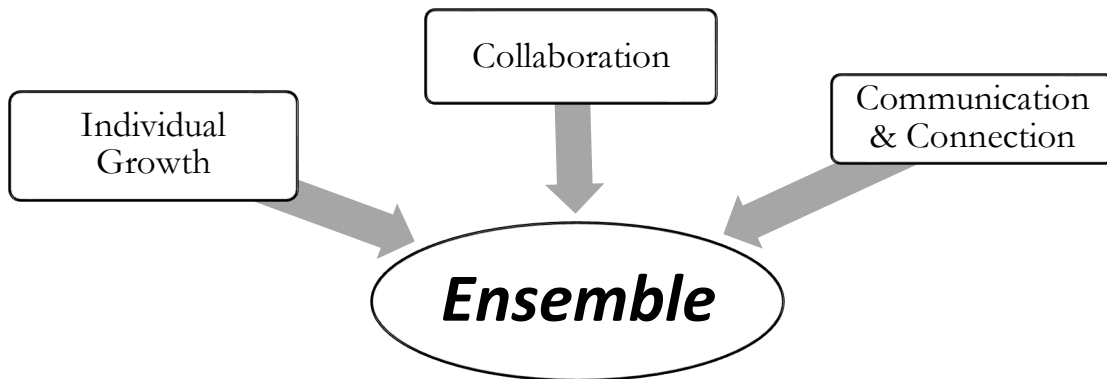
