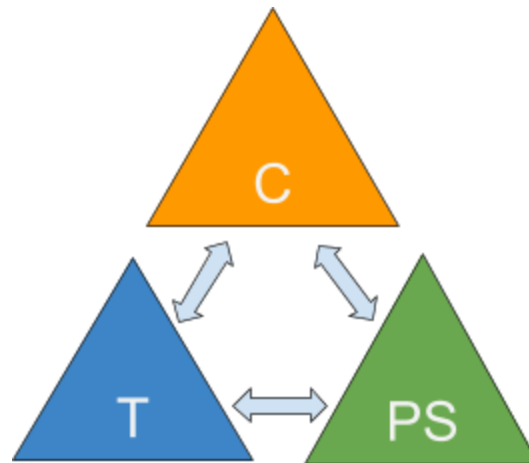


Argyle Learning Centres
