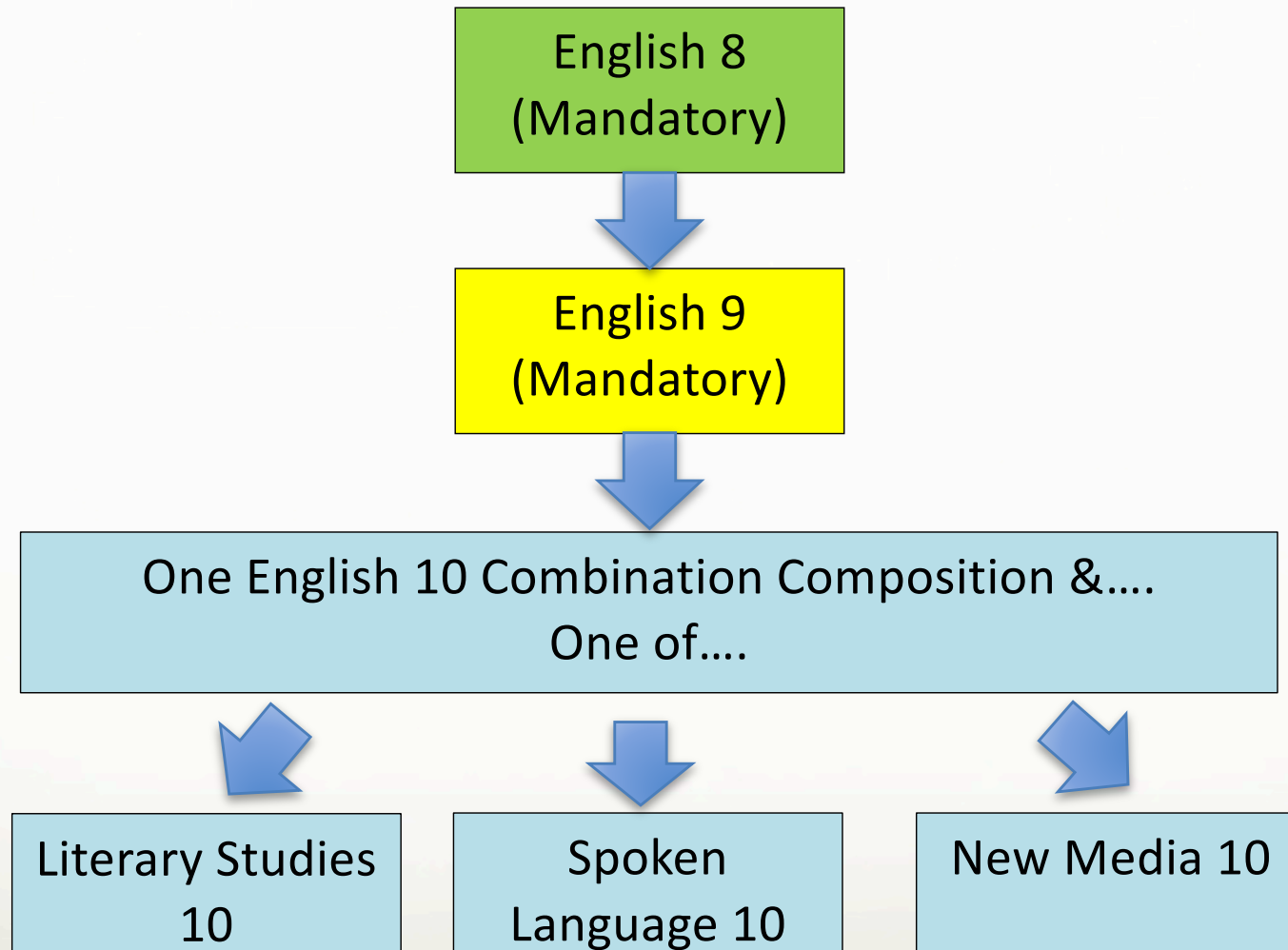

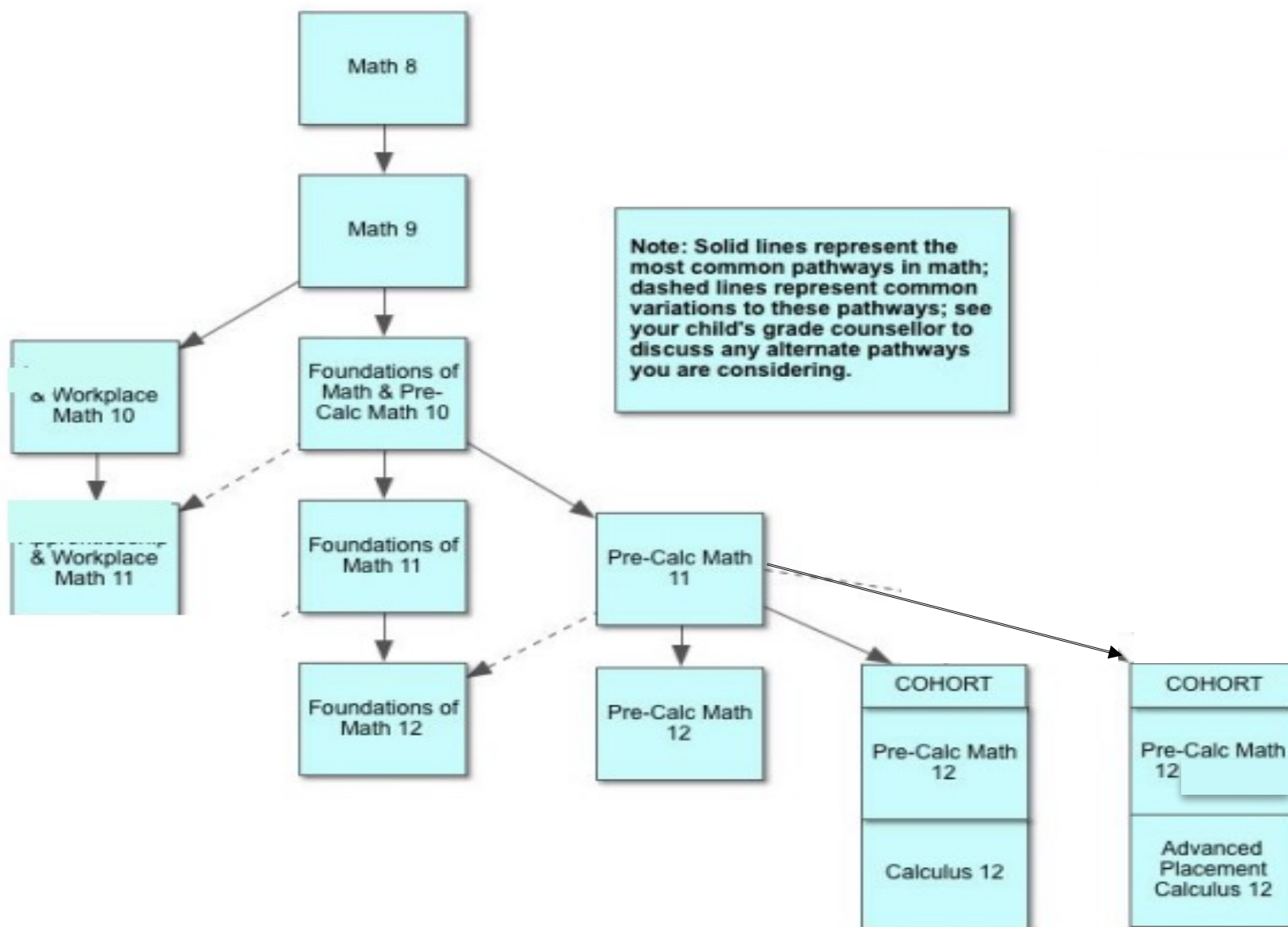
Grade 9 & 10 English Pathway



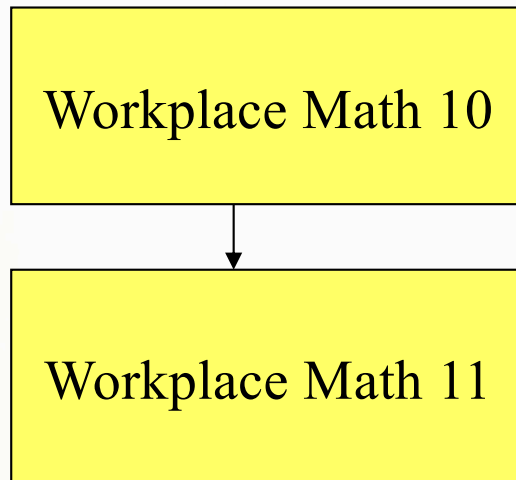


MATHEMATICS

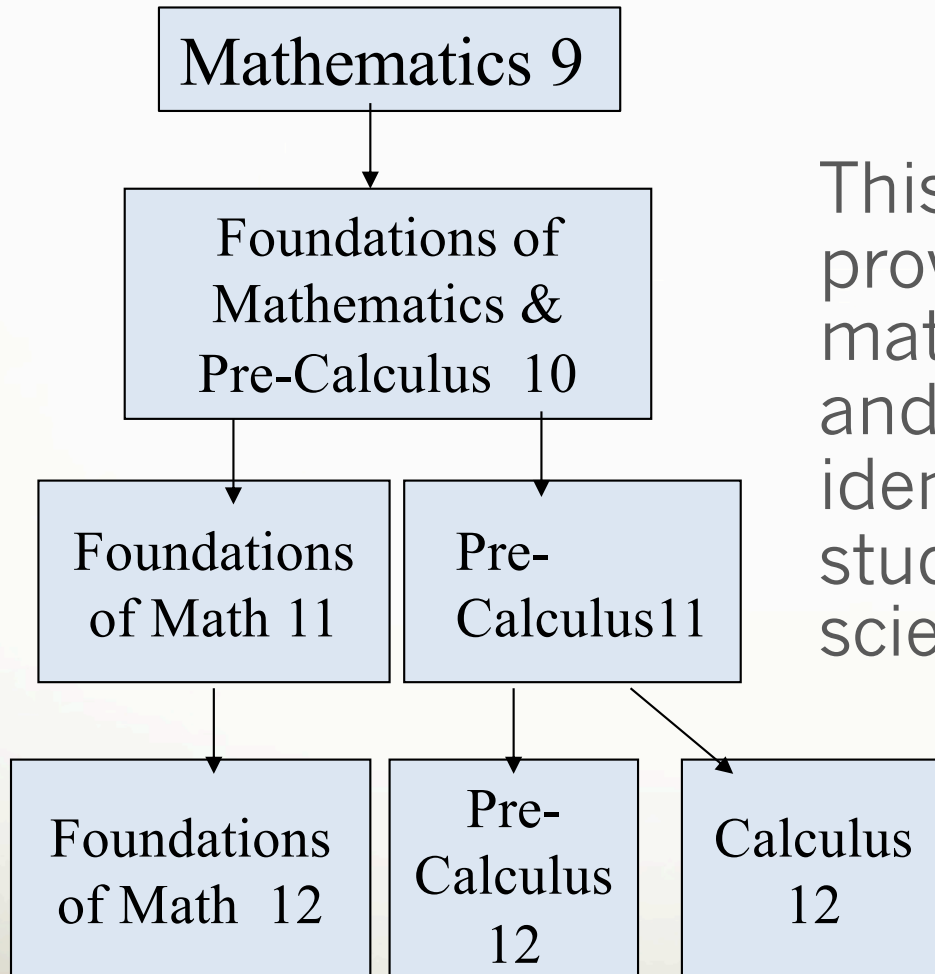


This course is designed to provide students with the mathematical understandings and critical thinking skills identified for entry into the majority of trades, and for direct entry into the work force.




