The **North Shore Community Foundation -Gordon Smith Outstanding Visual Artist** award is available to a graduating North Vancouver School District student who has demonstrated excellence in the Visual Arts and is planning to continue their education in the Visual & Media Arts.

##### **Evaluation Criteria:**

Scholarship applications and supporting material will be evaluated on:

- artistic ability, range and vision within the visual arts
- the quality of the presentation for this application

#### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- The names and email addresses of two references (at least one teacher) that can support your application
- Introductory letter
  - Include your post-secondary education plans and career goals.
  - Outline your artistic strengths and interests.
  - Describe your school and community activities or involvement.
- School based transcripts (grade 11 & 12)
- Images from 5 artworks from the last two years
- 2-3 images from your sketchbook showing your creative thinking process
- List of works including Title, Medium, Date Created and Dimensions (if applicable) for all artworks, and sketchbook images
