We regret that at this time international students are not eligible.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The **Jack Shadbolt Multiple Arts Excellence** award is available to a graduating North Vancouver School District student who has demonstrated excellence in two or more of the Arts disciplines (*ie. visual art, music, dance, or drama & film*) and is planning to continue their education in the arts.

Evaluation Criteria:

Scholarship applications and supporting material will be evaluated on:

- artistic ability, range and vision within the visual arts
- the quality of the presentation for this application

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- The name and email address of two references (at least one teacher) that can support your application
- Introductory letter
 - Include your post-secondary education plans and career goals
 - Outline your artistic strengths and interests
 - Describe your school and community activities or involvement
- School based transcript (grade 11 & 12)
- Please check the TWO disciplines you are applying with:
 - Visual art – include images of 5 artworks from the last two years
 - Dance – include video of performance and indicate who you are
 - Music – include audio file and indicate your part
 - Film/theatre – include video of performance and indicate who you are
- Images from a sketchbook showing your creative thinking process. This can be annotated music, rough cuts of videos, notes of any kind.
- List of works including Title, Medium, Date Created and Dimensions (if applicable) for all artworks, video files, audio files and sketchbook images. Please indicate who you are or the role you played in any audio and video files.
