

Artists for Kids Gordon Smith Gallery Self-Guided Instructions and Gallery Expectations

Thanks for attending the AFK Gallery Orientation for Self-Guided Visits! We're looking forward to hosting you and your students at the Gallery. After today's workshop, we will send out a MS Bookings link where you can sign up for available dates and times.

What you need to know before your visit:

Location

- Our address is 2121 Lonsdale Avenue. Parking is available at Centennial Theatre and on surrounding streets.

Health and Safety

- Health and safety protocols for your self-guided tour will need to align with the current health and safety directives of the Provincial Health Officer.
- The group must meet the supervision requirements for Field Trips as per District Policy 207. This consists of 1 teacher supervisor per class and 1 approved supervisor (with a ratio of 1 adult for every 15 students).

Arrival

- Have your class meet in the lobby by the entrance to the Gallery – supervision is the responsibility of the teacher, parent drivers should not leave students unsupervised.
- Check in at the AFK office, one of our staff will open the gallery for you, give you a set of keys, and welcome you and your class.

Behaviour Expectations in the Gallery **(please review with your class)**

- Please do not touch or lean against the artwork or walls.
- There is no running in the Gallery, please walk.
- Use quiet indoor voices as the space echoes.
- Respect others' ideas and interpretations of the artwork.

Departure

- Let the AFK office know you are leaving (return any keys we've given you).
