Important Information:

- * School staff will be working and will begin planning for Educational Continuity and the
 continuation of learning. More info on details will be provided later, but teachers will
 begin connecting with/contacting students later in the week. Speak to the importance
 of connection and relationships, especially in uncertain times.
- * Over the next 2 weeks, schedules will be established to allow for students, if necessary, to collect personal possessions and/or resources. Controlled access to the building is required to ensure social/physical distancing and to keep buildings safe.
