### Walk and Wheel Wednesdays

Between April 17 and June 5 students were encouraged to walk or roll to school each day of the week. On Wednesdays, we surveyed the students on how they got to and from school. For students who lived far away, they could be dropped off a few blocks away and walk the rest of the way to school.

This would count as walking or rolling. The top two divisions who walked or rolled each week received the Bobcat Award to keep for one week, as well, they received a Brilliant Bobcat Button. Thank you to all students who participated in this event. For the final week of this event 78% of students either walked or rolled to and from school, with an overall average for this event being 72% of Boundary students walking and rolling! ## **Boundary Emergency Release Drill – IMPORTANT**

Please inform your child(ren) who will be picking them up. This will help settle them during this exercise.

We will be having an Emergency Release Drill on Friday, June 14th. On that afternoon, Boundary will be doing an Earthquake Drill followed by an outside evacuation; the students will then be released following the Emergency Release procedures to parents/guardians/emergency contacts from 1:15pm to 3:00pm. Students will only be released to parents/guardians or emergency contacts that are already in our school's database. If the person picking up your child(ren) is not already identified in your emergency contacts list AND/OR does not have proper identification to authenticate their identity, we will not be able to release your child(ren) from our school until 3:00pm. Please ensure that your emergency contacts at Boundary are up-to-date! Please be mindful that this drill will require time and patience as it will take time to conduct this drill in an efficient and effective manner, but we would like to ensure the safety of your children so we will be following protocol during this drill.
