

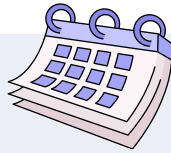

Spring School Dance! Friday, April 10th

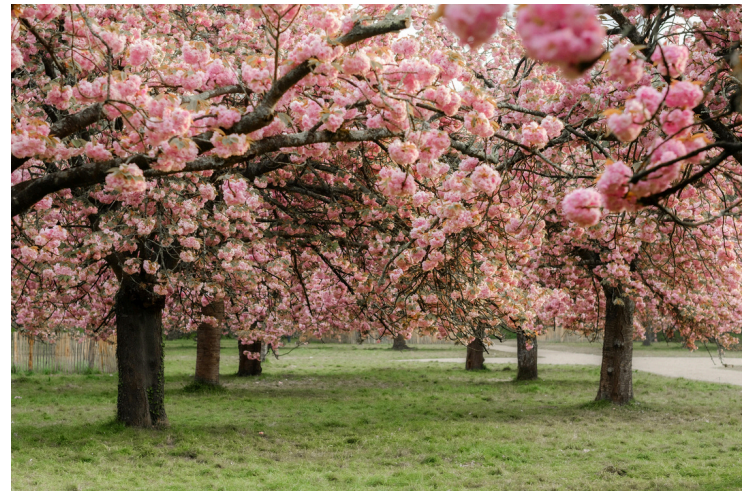
DJ Rachel is BACK! And she rocks!
