Band and Strings Registration - 2024/25 Elementary Band & Strings - Registration Opens January 15, 2024

Registration for the 2024/25 Elementary Band and Strings program will open on Monday, January 15, 2024. The NVSD public webpage for the [Band and Strings](#) has been updated and now contains the information for the 2024/25 school year.

There are two registration options and fees for 2024/25:

- Registration between January 15 - February 29, 2024 – the fee is \$535 and can be paid through a monthly instalment plan that will be in place until September 1st.
- Registration between March 11 - September 27, 2024 (Late Registration*) – the fee will be \$600. No monthly installment plan is available for this option.

* As noted below, low early registration numbers may impact the Late Registration option.

Families can withdraw their child from the program and receive a FULL refund up to June 14, 2024. After this date, a \$75 fee will be charged.

Applications for bursaries are available, please reach out to the school (capilano@sd44.ca) if you require a form.
