In the Family Portal, parents and guardians with an account can view, save, and print their child(s) Learning Updates.

Go to sd44.ca then click the Parents link in the top right.

Parent accounts will be created on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of each month for parents and guardians that have provided an email address to the school. Your Login ID and a temporary password will be sent to the email address provided.

# Note: sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca is the MyEducation system email address - do not delete this email when it arrives. If you do not receive the email, check your Trash/Junk/Spam folders in case it was redirected.





Popups should be enabled for some features of the site to work properly.

When you log in for the first time, you will be prompted to change your password and set up a security question. It is important to remember the answer to your security question, as it will allow you to reset your password if you forget it.

The Login ID and Password can be found in the email sent by the system when the account is created.

Note: If a MyEd account with this Login ID already exists in the system, the system will add a number to the end. (e.g. <u>mariaadducci@fakeemail.com2</u>)

This often happens when a parent has children in different school districts, as accounts are created for each district. OR, if both parents/guardians want to use the same email. (If this is the case, we suggest that only one parent has the email entered, so only one parent account is created.) If this happens and you believe it to be in error, please contact your child's school.

## MyEducation BC How to reset your password

- 1. Go to https://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do
- 2. Click "I forgot my password"
- 3. Enter your Login ID and your Primary email (which usually is the same as your Login ID), then click **Continue**

NOTE:

If you have not set up your security question, or have forgotten the answer, you will not be able to reset your password using the "I forgot my password" link. Please contact your child's school to have your password reset.

- 4. Answer the security question (See NOTE) then Click Submit
- 5. An email will be sent to you from <a href="mailto:sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca">sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca</a> with a temporary password
- 6. After you log in with the temporary password, you will be prompted to create a new password
- 7. Enter your current password (the temporary password you just received), then enter a new password and confirm the new password

## MyEducation BC Login Tips and Troubleshooting for parents

1. Do not search the internet for the login page, use this one: <u>https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do</u>

Please bookmark this link, and/or make a desktop shortcut. Search results may return the MyEducation BC Test website (SDTest), which you will not be able to log into.

- 2. Your Login ID is provided to you by email, and will be sent from <a href="mailto:sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca">sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca</a> to the email address you have given to the school. Contact the school if you wish to change your email.
- 3. Do not copy/paste the password this sometimes adds a space. The password is case sensitive. If you forget your password, click on "I forgot my password" and you will be emailed a new temporary password.
- 4. Criteria to reset must be followed:
  - 8 minimum, 14 maximum characters
  - 1 capital letter, 1 lowercase letter
  - 1 number
  - 1 special character !, @, #, \$, etc.
  - Your password cannot contain, first name, middle name, last name, date of birth, personal ID or sequential letters or numbers
- 5. Ten unsuccessful log-in attempts will disable your account. If this happens, you will have to contact the school for it to be re-enabled. There will be no staff in schools after Mid-July, as well as during Spring Break and Winter Break you will need to wait until school is back in session.
- 6. Passwords are good for 90 days, after which time you must create a new password.
- 7. If you have trouble logging in or viewing report cards, try another web browser such as Edge or Firefox. If you use a mobile device, try a regular computer.
- 8. If you login and do not see a report card, it may be because you have logged in before the report card is published. Typically, the school posts the date they will publish, and you will receive an email notifying you that report cards have been published. If after that date you do not see the report card, contact the school directly.
- 9. If you have any issues, please report them to the school office, and they will report the issues to the district ICT department.
