MyEducation (MyED) BC Parent Portal Report Cards

NEW Parents to Capilano:

We have received a high volume of inquires since report cards were published and we are responding as quickly as possible. We appreciate your patience as it is a busy time of year before the break.

Once an active student, the North Vancouver School District creates MyED Parent Portal Accounts. **Shortly after your student's first day of class, you will have received an email from MyEducation BC with instructions about how to log into the MyED Parent Portal.

Please search your inbox, including your junk inbox, for an email from **sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca** which will include your Login ID and temporary password.

Content in the email will include the following information: **Welcome to the Capilano MyEducation BC PARENT PORTAL** and will allow access to your student's published report cards, attendance and other information.



CLICK HERE to LOGIN (instructions below) [MyEducation BC: Log On \(gov.bc.ca\)](https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca)

1. *Once entered, you will get a message that your password has expired (this is normal) and to create a new password.
2. *Simply enter the temporary password again as your current password and then create and confirm a new one for yourself. You may need to create security questions as well.
3. *DO NOT select save password as they expire every 90 days, and it can create future issues.
4. ***Please remember to record your Login ID, new password, and security question answers** - you will need to answer these questions to reset your password after the next 90 days.
5. You should now be able to see your student's term 2 report card - **please save or print for your reference, report cards are removed from the portal in July and will no longer be available.**

- Let us know if you have any other students currently at another school within the North Vancouver School District (SD44).

~~~Please note that the Ministry of Education requires that passwords on MyED expire every 90 days so it is recommend parents reset their passwords and ensure they can successfully log in before the next report card publication date.

# MyEducation (MyED) BC Parent Portal Report Cards

## RETURNING Capilano Parents:

We have received a high volume of inquiries since report cards were published and we are responding as quickly as possible. We appreciate your patience as it is a busy time of year before the break.

### Troubleshooting Tips;

- Passwords expire after 90 days so you will need to reset them periodically.
- Your Login ID and Primary email address are the same and should be the one we have on file for you at the school.
- Once you enter the correct email address as the log in, you can select '**forgot password**'
- You will be asked to enter your primary email address (same one we have on file for you) and to answer the security question previously provided.

\*\*\*IF the same email address on file is not entered as your primary email here - you may get an 'Email cannot be verified' error

\*\*\*IF your security question auto populates with a previous answer, delete the auto populated answer and enter the appropriate answer before clicking OK

- You should be able to reset your password as above, *unless* you have tried more than 10 times to access the account and get a message that you are locked out.
- If you get a locked-out message, then please email [capilano@sd44.ca](mailto:capilano@sd44.ca) with the following information:
  - Parent/Guardian name AND,
  - Student's full name and grade.
  - Let us know if you have any other students currently at another school within the North Vancouver School District (SD44).
- \*Best practice is to log in from a laptop/computer rather than phone.

All report cards are removed from MyED every July and parents will no longer have access to them. When you login in September, you will NOT see reports from previous school years.

## WHEN SHOULD I KEEP MY SICK CHILD HOME FROM SCHOOL?

### Things to consider if your child feels unwell:

1. The wellbeing of your child. Without proper rest, a child may have a hard time fighting an illness or be at risk for other illnesses.
2. The ability of your child to actively take part and learn at school.
3. The school staff cannot care for a sick child and give them the support that they may need.
4. The protection of other children.

### Please keep your child home if they:

- Have a fever.
- Are too sick to take part in all normal school activities.
- Have a suspected or known communicable disease (i.e. strep throat, chicken pox, measles).
- Is vomiting or has diarrhea. It is recommended that students be symptom free at least 24 hours before returning to school.

Keep your child home until they are able to participate fully in normal school activities or as told by a health care provider.

*Please let the school know your child's symptoms, as per the school's call back procedures.*

If the school finds it necessary to send your child home because of illness, please make sure you have arranged an emergency contact if you are not available. Inform your school of these arrangements.
