Dogs on School Grounds

This is a reminder that there are no dogs of any age allowed on school property. There is a bylaw in the District of North Vancouver prohibiting dogs from certain public spaces such as school grounds – (for exact wording of the regulation 5981, please refer to the North Vancouver District website restricting dogs from school grounds). While the wording of the bylaw only applies to dogs three months and older, schools being private property allows for the restriction to be extended to dogs of any age at the school district's discretion.

While our four-legged friends are usually just that – friends – some children at school are allergic to dogs and/or have other health conditions which can be complicated due to exposure, while others can often be frightened of them. Even when leashed or tethered to a fence, dogs can be unpredictable especially when the owner is not present. These factors combine to result in concerns relating to student safety and well-being.

Therefore, the restriction of dogs of any age from school grounds is in alignment with school district <u>Policy: 301</u>. It is also important to note, that in some cases, and despite many owners' best efforts, dogs can and do leave 'calling cards' on the playgrounds – not pleasant for anyone who may step or slide into them unintentionally. Please be aware that animals are allowed in schools only when in alignment with <u>Policy: 212</u>. Thank you in advance for helping us maintain a safe and pleasant environment for all members of our school community.
